DVLA

New policy which came into effect on the 26th of August should make things easier for groups like ourselves when keeping vehicles on the road. Major changes mean

Like for like repairs and restorations will no longer need to be reported to DVLA. providing the vehicles appearance is the same as when manufactured

Vehicles that have had structural modifications will be able to keep their original VIN and registration number but DVLA must be informed of changes

Vehicles that have been converted to electric will also be able to retain their original identity, but the registered keeper must notify DVLA.
